Personal Care

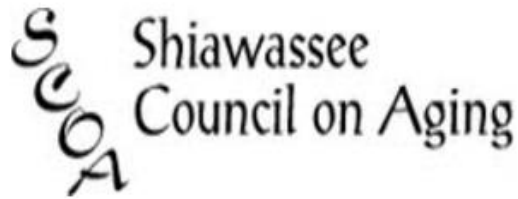
